

Calculating *Tier 2* and *Tier 3* dimensions

Tier 2 and Tier 3 of the skirt are just 4 giant rectangles, so I figured you wouldn't want to waste any time or paper to print those out. You can just use a ruler instead!

 **YOU WILL NEED TO CUT 2 RECTANGLES OF EACH TIER (4 TOTAL).**


WIDTH

Here are the dimensions of Tier 2 and Tier 3 width for each size (based on your HIP measurement). The width should be cut perpendicular to the selvage edge of your fabric.

| Size | Tier 2 width | | Tier 3 width | |
|----------------|--------------|--------|--------------|--------|
| X-Small | 31.5 in | 80 cm | 44.25 in | 113 cm |
| Small | 32.5 in | 82 cm | 45.5 in | 115 cm |
| Medium | 33 in | 84 cm | 46 in | 117 cm |
| Large | 34 in | 87 cm | 48 in | 121 cm |
| X-Large | 35 in | 89 cm | 49 in | 125 cm |
| 2XL | 36.5 in | 93 cm | 51 in | 130 cm |
| 3XL | 38 in | 96 cm | 53 in | 134 cm |
| 4XL | 39.5 in | 100 cm | 55 in | 140 cm |
| 5XL | 41 in | 105 cm | 57.5 in | 146 cm |

HEIGHT

These are the dimensions (for all sizes) for the Tier 2 and Tier 3 rectangle height. The height should be cut parallel to the selvage edge of your fabric.

 If you use the height adjustment calculator and need to add or subtract length, divide the difference between the three tiers.

| Tier 2 height | | Tier 3 height | |
|---------------|-------|---------------|-------|
| 13 in | 34 cm | 14.5 in | 36 cm |
